





As a reminder, if you are eligible to vote, you must be a current, paid, REALTOR(R) member registered for the Women's Council conference with corresponding fees paid, as per Article X, Section 4 of the national bylaws. See National Bylaws for voting eligibility. Designated alternate voter procedures and timelines were advised on 3/17/22 to all network leaders. **All voting delegates must register for the conference by April 21st at 11:59 p.m. CST in order to be eligible to vote.** Local Delegates, Governing Board, and members-at-large will check-in for the election and must be physically present to vote. There are no exceptions unless the member explains in writing before the deadline why they are unable to register.
