Real Estate Agent's Murder Hits Home for Realtors

Real estate agent Beverly Carter was found dead, her body buried in a shallow grave behind a concrete mixing plant north of Little Rock. It was a senseless and seemingly random act of violence against a woman who at the time was only doing her job. Her death is a tragic reminder of the hidden perils real estate agents potentially face every day.



"She was just a woman that worked alone — a rich broker," said the man charged with her murder, in response to questions about his motives.

Selling real estate is a solitary profession that involves escorting virtual strangers into sometimes vacant properties at a moment's notice. Advertising — usually accompanied by an agent's photograph and phone number — is virtually a requirement for the majority of agents who work for commission.

According to the National Association of Realtors, 57% of agents are women and a 2011 report on violent crimes against real estates agents found that women were disproportionately victimized. Open houses in particular can be perilous affairs where agents – who are often alone in an otherwise empty home – feel like "sitting ducks." Beverly did many of the things that agents are trained to do: She left her purse in her car to avoid theft, and she called her husband to give him her exact location. It wasn't enough.

The app will track you via GPS throughout your predefined journey time until you check in safely. If you fail to do so when time's up, your emergency contact list gets notified immediately via email, Facebook or SMS.

The App puts the power in your hands. All you do is shake your phone to trigger an emergency alert immediately and turn on your phone's camera to record what's going on.
